Purpose

NA Wahine is an Autonomous group of women recovering in Narcotics Anonymous that meet annually to renew our Spiritual Connection.

Brief History

One woman from Waimea spoke with another woman in Hilo about the lack of women having a venue or event for recovery. It was decided to have a retreat which began at Kalopa State Park in 2002.

The idea for the name was chosen by the Waimea woman (NA Wahine) as a play on words for women in recovery. NA (The), Wahine (Woman), as NA is the acronym for Narcotics Anonymous.

The event went over so well that it was decided to become an annual event. It now meets annually in Makapala, North Kohala. The seed money was put up by 3 women from Hilo and the 1 from Waimea. "In keeping with the spirit of NAWS Bulletin 18 (special interest meetings) we continue to seed ourselves and donate to Region or Area as dictated by our group conscience"
