WHY REGISTER EARLY?

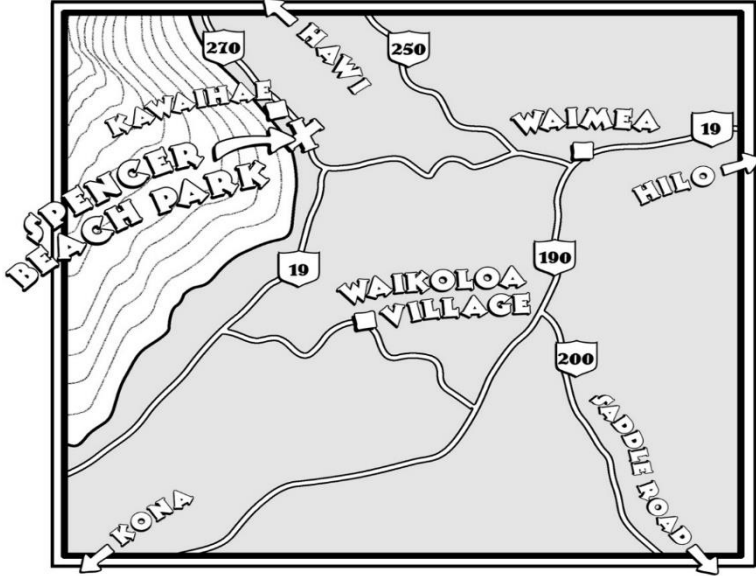
